Dr. Abha kheterpal motivated the students as well as faculty members for participating and organising such kind of programs. Dr. Rachna soni said that these digital skills are required nowadays amid the pandemic as everything is online.

On the first day of program Ms. Ashima Sharma commenced the session with the topic "ESSENTIAL GUIDE FOR EVERYONE-GOOGLE BASED TOOLS" and elaborated various tools and techniques of Google such as Gmail Essentials, Google Drive, Google Photos and Google forms etc. On the second day Ms. Upasana Kapoor explained the features of Microsoft 365 titled "THE HUB FOR TEAMWORK-MICROSOFT TEAMS" that includes Microsoft Outlook, OneDrive, Microsoft form, OneNote, ,sway. She also elaborated that how this platform is used by the College for online classes in this pandemic period.


On the 3rd day, Ms. Kitty started the session with the topic of "LEVEL UP YOUR MICROSOFT OFFICE AUTOMATION TOOLS". She explained the latest features of Office 365-Excel such as Filter function, unique, xlookup, sequence functions, sorting, concatenation, join, etc.

4th Day of the program was initiated by Ms. Vinita Gulati. She explained "OFFICE 365-WORD" latest features such as Dictation, Transcribe, Real Time For Co-Authoring, more functions through ADD-IN etc.


Celebration of Nutrition Week-

POSHAN MAH was celebrated by the Department of Home Science, DAV College For Girls Yamunanagar Under IDA Chandigarh Chapter in which an online educational Program on Anaemia and PCOS in collaboration with IMA WDW.(woman doctor wing) Jagadhri ,Yamunanagar was organised on 21 Sept 21 . It was sponsored by CADILA Pharmaceuticals Ltd, in which Dr. Ritu Mago (MD ,OBS and Gynae) discussed about the PCOS i.e. Polycystic ovarian syndrome which is the most common hormonal disorder among youngsters and women these days.She gave detailed information about the common symptoms of PCOS like acne ,irregular periods ,heavy bleeding ,hair growth, weight gain and also about the prevention of PCOS. Dr. Manishi (MD, OBS and Gynae) addressed students about the anemia and importance of hemoglobin along with their common symptoms i.e.tiredness and weakness. 
Wall Painting Competition
