## Details of activities that inculcate values; necessary to render students into responsible citizens

- 1. Legal Literacy Cell, Human Rights Society and Department of Political Science organized Extension Lecture on, "Women Rights: Legal Perspective" under the supervision of Dr. Shikha Saini, Head Deptt. of Political Science and Mrs. Sabhyata Bansal, Deptt. of Human Rights. The lecture was delivered by Ms. Diksha Khera, Advocate, District and Sessions Court, Yamuna Nagar wherein she guided the students about various Women Rights such as freedom from all types of violence, freedom from slavery, to be educated, to own property, to vote, to earn a fair and equal wage etc. She emphasized that when women and girls have full access to these rights, then all women and girls will have the self determination. The students were also informed about the relevant legislative provisions with regard to the above rights and also the procedure of exercising these rights in case of difficulty. The lecture was very informative and interactive. Around 60 students of Political Science and Human Rights actively participated in the lecture.
  - 2. The Legal Literacy Cell in collaboration with Dept. of Political Science, DAV College for Girls on the occasion of Constitution day administered oath to the students of the college. Oath was administered under the able guidance of madam principal Dr. Meenu Jain along with other staff members of legal literacy cell. 
