Subject: Verification of Aadhaar Seeding and Status of Bank Accounts of
Beneficiaries Showing PFMS Failure on NSP.

It has been observed that the payment status of a number of beneficiaries under the Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC students and Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for OBC, EBC & DNT students on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) is reflecting as "PFMS Rejected."

One of the possible reasons for such failure may be that the beneficiary's bank account is not Aadhaar-seeded or the bank account has become inactive/dormant.

In view of the above, you are requested to immediately inform all concerned institutions and the affected beneficiaries under your jurisdiction to:

- Ensure that their bank account is duly Aadhaar-seeded.
- Ensure that the bank account is active and operational.

Get the above deficiencies rectified at the earliest to facilitate successful processing of scholarship payment through PFMS.

This matter may be treated as Most Urgent and necessary action may be taken immediately. A wide publicity of the above instructions may also be ensured among all concerned beneficiaries.

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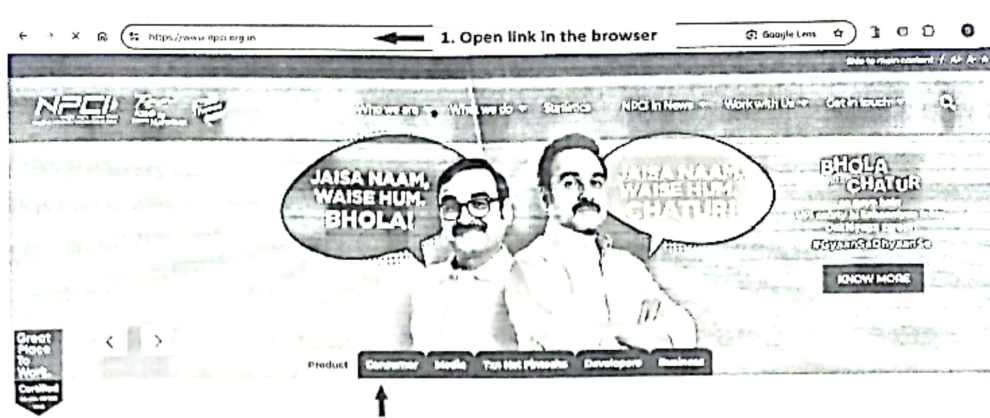

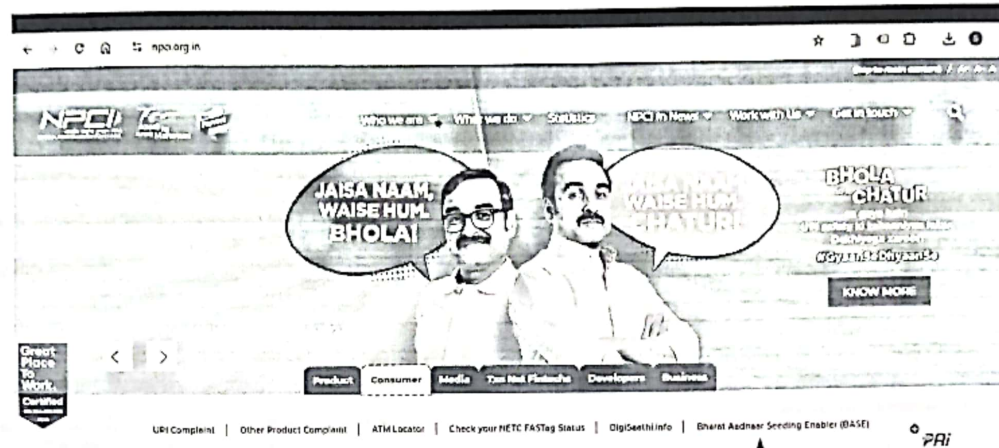

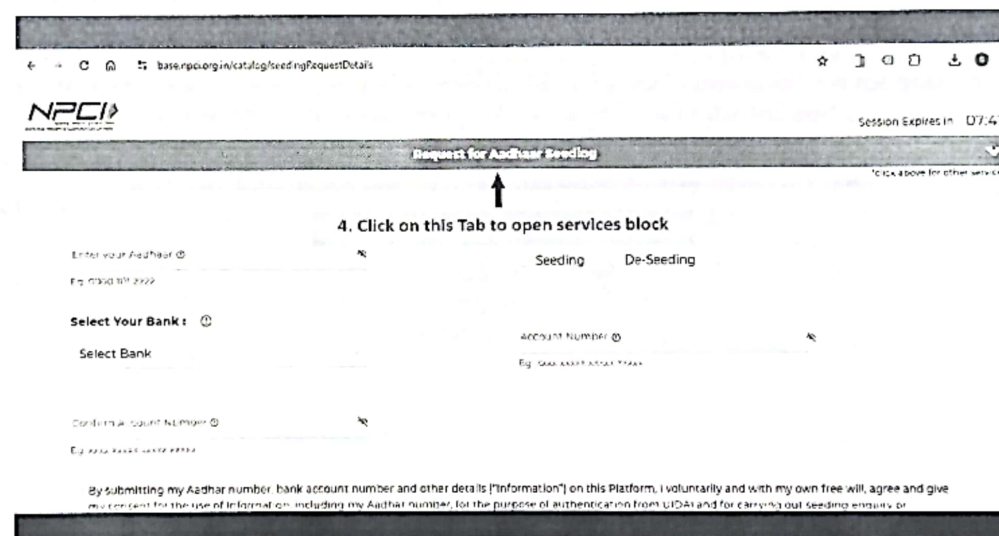

Subject: Utilization of functionality of Aadhaar Seeding with beneficiaries bank account developed by NPCI-reg.

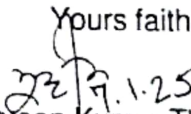
Respected Sir/Madam,

With reference to letter No. K-11017/1/2022-SCD-V, dated 8th July, 2024 regarding using of Aadhaar Payment Bridge (ABP) and Aadhaar seeding with student's bank account under the schemes of Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC Students and Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC Students & others, it has been noticed that some students are facing problem in seeding Aadhaar with their bank account as highlighted by the various States & UTs in different meetings.

2. In the context, National Payment Corporation India (NPCI) has developed a utility to facilitate a DBT beneficiary to manage the seeding process seamlessly through "Bharath Aadhaar Seeding Enabler (BASE)". BASE shall be the interface between various channels through which Aadhaar seeding request can be raised, NPCI mapper and the banks. The platform will use various APIs for the eco system to communicate online/offline for seeding requests. Further, the functionality is available for all nationalised banks.

3. States/UTs, willing to use this facility, may arrange camps in the institutes and also issue instructions/advisory to the students and all stake holders for Aadhaar Seeding with student's bank account by navigating [https://www.npci.org.in/->consumer-> Bharath Aadhaar Seeding Enabler \(BASE\)](https://www.npci.org.in/->consumer-> Bharath Aadhaar Seeding Enabler (BASE)). The BASE NPCI reference document is attached herewith for ready reference. The States and UTs are requested to make the best use of this facility so that the cases can be processed at priority.
